



Education

Despite a very low per capita income (US \$220 in 1994), which places Vietnam among the poorest nations in the world, the rate of literacy (89%) is exceptionally high compared with the least developed countries. The average years in school is 4 to 9 (5 to 8 years for boys and 3 to 4 years for girls).

The rate of schooling for the age group 12-17 is 47%. All the schools in Vietnam have been nationalized since the reunification of the country. Education is free and compulsory, which constantly helps in the effort of eradicating illiteracy in Vietnam. This constitutes an essential component for a rapid development in the future.
