



February: le **Tết Nguyên Đán**, the festival of Vietnamese New Year is the main and most colorful festivity of the year. The fiesta lasts at least 3 days. It is the occasion of huge consumption of incense, flowers and fireworks.

Mid-March: Woman's Day and celebration in memory of national heroines: the 2 Trung sisters.

April: Festival of king **Hùng Vương**, founder of the nation: a cult motivated by legendary traditions.

Mid-May: Festival of Buddha. Processions and religious ceremonies, pilgrimages to temples

September: Festival of Mid-Autumn, dedicated particularly more to children, brightened by torches and captivated by the dances of the Unicorn (animal known for its intelligence and protecting character).

End of September: Festival of Confucius.
